## CYCLE THE GREENWAY

Here's a «wheelie» good way to start your day: ride the greenway and drink in our diverse scenery. You're spoilt for choice: head to Sète (15km) and ride on the lido, a long strip of sand between the Mediterranean Sea and Thau Lagoon, or make a beeline for Mèze (16km) on a route best suited to mountain bikes.

## SALTY SNACK



Settle down at your table with views of Thau Lagoon for a seafood platter and our famous Mediterranean oysters with their signature hazelnut flavour. Several shellfish farms serve their produce. You're in for an explosion of flavour, washed down by a cold and fragrant local white wine.

## CANAL DU MIDI AND THAU LAGOON

In the afternoon, head to Pointe des Onglous where the Canal du Midi meets Thau Lagoon. Soak up views of the small inland sea, Sète and Mont Saint-Clair from the end of the long jetty.

Or... uncover the secrets of the lagoon and shellfish farming on a boat trip from Marseillan-Ville and Marseillan-Plage.
